☞ Additional hourly rental beyond your allotted rental time is available for \$100 per hour.

☞ Holidays are subject to Saturday evening rates.

RENTAL FEES INCLUDE:

☞ The use of the building for five hours for an evening event, and four hours for a daytime event. You are given access to the building two hours prior to your rental time for the set up of evening events, and one hour prior for daytime events. You are also allowed one hour after your event for clean up.

☞ A host on site for your entire event.

☞ A security guard at the entrance gate to allow your guests into the park for your event.

The Memorial House will set up and break down all tables and chairs to your specifications. Tables may be set up within the Memorial House or on the south lawn. Upholstered chairs may not be set up outside.

☞ Linens, in your choice of color and size for up to fourteen tables. Additional linens can be rented if needed.

WEDDING CEREMONY RATE: **\$300**

The Memorial House and Memory Grove Park offers many beautiful settings for a wedding ceremony. The main hall of the Memorial House is available year-round for wedding ceremonies. During the warmer months, you may also choose to have your ceremony outside in the park. Popular outdoor locations include the south lawn, in front of the Meditation Chapel, and by the white monument. If you choose to have an outdoor ceremony, the main hall is always available in the event of bad weather.

If you are not renting Memorial House for your reception, but would like to hold your wedding ceremony at Memorial House or in Memory Grove Park, we can accommodate wedding ceremonies for a \$500 fee for a two hour window. Wedding ceremonies that do not include a reception at Memorial House are subject to additional booking restrictions. Please ask your Memorial House representative for more information.

WEDDING CEREMONY RATE INCLUDES:

☞ Your choice of location within Memory Grove Park and the Memorial House.

☞ The use of up to 100 white resin chairs. Memorial House staff will set up and breakdown chairs.

☞ An additional staff person during the ceremony.

☞ Use of the bride's room to change and store personal items.

☞ A one-hour rehearsal hosted by our knowledgeable staff. Rehearsal dates and times will be confirmed two weeks prior to the rehearsal. Rehearsals will be scheduled around existing events at the Memorial House, and will be scheduled on weekdays between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm. Every effort will be made to meet your requested date and time.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I secure a date?

Reservations require a signed contract and a non-refundable deposit of \$500 that is applied to the rental fee total. The remaining balance is due 45 days prior to your event.

How much is the security deposit and what is it used for?

A separate, fully refundable cleaning/damage deposit of \$500 is due 45 days prior to your rental date. If no damage occurs, your cleaning/damage deposit will be refunded within one week after your event.

When do we finalize the details of my event?

We will set up an appointment to review all of the details of your event 45 days prior.

If you are interested in using a caterer that is not on our preferred list, we can accommodate one-time caterers for a small fee. Please note that all one-time caterers must provide proof of insurance, business license, food handler's permits and some additional documentation. All one-time caterers are subject to approval and must be confirmed 45 days prior to your event. Please ask your Memorial House representative for more information. For safety reasons, all food served at the Memorial House must be provided by a licensed caterer. Wedding cakes may be arranged through the bakery of your choice.

Can I serve alcohol at my event?

Alcohol is allowed at the Memorial House. Bar service must be arranged through our preferred caterers or an approved bartending service to ensure that bartenders are certified, licensed, and insured.

How many people can the Memorial House accommodate?

For the comfort of your guests, we ask that the maximum number of guests be limited to 300 people. We can accommodate up to 150 people in the main hall for a sit down dinner, and depending on your desired set up, additional dining space for a sit down dinner may be available in the garden room, patio or the south lawn.

What time does our event need to end?

The Memorial House is located within a Salt Lake City park. Park curfew is 11:00 pm. Everyone, including catering and other hired staff, must exit the park by 11:00 pm; therefore events must end at 10:00 pm.

How can I decorate the building?

You are welcome to decorate as you wish at the Memorial House; however, the Memorial House is a historic building, so tacking, taping, nailing, and tying to any surfaces is not allowed. Candles are allowed as long as the flame is contained within glass. Sparklers and other forms of fireworks are not allowed. Items that are difficult to clean up such as rice, confetti, birdseed, flower petals, streamers, and balloon releases are not permitted. Bubbles are a good alternative.

Who owns Memorial House?

Memorial House is owned by Salt Lake City and is operated by Utah Heritage Foundation, a statewide organization dedicated to preserving, protecting and promoting Utah's historic architecture. Therefore rental of Memorial House directly supports Utah Heritage Foundation's mission that includes stewardship of historic Memorial House.
